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A BROKEN LEG STILL?

It started some months ago when this fellow thought He hurt His leg. In a couple of months or so He went to the Doctor with a broken Femur, which is the only bone connecting His sore knee to the Hip, what a mess. But the Doctor on call at the Hospital said, “ the bones in this man are to good to use a complete Hip Replacement so I screwed and nailed the bone back together again”. This was in September. He saw the patient again in November, A long wait for the patient to see what the Doc that nailed and screwed his main connection from the Knee to the Hip together. “You are doing fine go home and put some wait on the Injured Leg and come back in two months”. Well, about a week before the visit to the Doc. The patient was in severe pain. He had to see a Nurse Practitioner, and said there was some bone behind the femur crushed and the next week the Doc. Said the same thing except He spun it around to make it come out the same.

Doc. Said go home and do nothing for eight weeks except sit around and use the broken leg just to balance the body when doing necessary things as going to bed etc. After eight weeks the Doc. Told the patient to put about a hundred pounds on the injured leg and come back. After that eight weeks the Doc. Said to keep doing the same thing for eight more weeks (July, ten months after surgery) folks if you are old don't break you femur. When the patient studied about the structure of the body in college He learned there are only 206 bones in the whole body, just don't break the femur, the only connection you have between the knee and the hip. Now that is some connection.
